Announcement (2/2024)

28<sup>th</sup> February 2024

1. The Arakan Army (AA) announced that the terrorist Military Council's jet fighter intentionally targeted and attacked the Min Phoo Hospital in Minbya Township, Rakhine state, at 1:45 am on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2024. At the time of the strike, the hospital has been treating patients, including captured Myanmar military soldiers and their family members, leaving many injured patients and health staff.
2. On 20<sup>th</sup> February 2024, the terrorist Military Council launched airstrikes at Ramree Township, Rakhine State targeting and destroying the entire Myoma Hospital, Myoma bazaar, a nunnery, and people's houses.
3. On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2024, the terrorist Military Council launched airstrikes four times targeting the public Hospital in Kawlin Town, Sagaing Region, destroying the whole hospital, but fortunately, patients and hospital staff were safe due to timely evacuation.
4. The terrorist Military Council committed inhumane attacks on the health sector and innocent civilians repeatedly and intentionally, breaking the Geneva Conventions, the UN Security Council's Resolutions, and International Humanitarian and Human Rights laws.

5. From 1 February 2021 to date, the Military Council brutally attacked more than (1,200) times on the health sector in Myanmar, damaged (308) health facilities, killed (104) health workers, and injured (136) health workers. (Reference: <https://insecurityinsight.org/country-pages/myanmar/>)
6. The Ministry of Health of the National Unity Government, condemns those extremely inhumane acts of violence by the terrorist Military Council and stands together with the ULA/AA, the people of Arakan, and the people of Myanmar.
7. The Ministry also vows to seek judicial redress for the lives of those innocent members of the public and healthcare workers. We pledge that the terrorist Military Council and its lackeys see justice served on them. We strongly urge the international community, to take vigorous actions immediately to halt the Myanmar military Council's escalating attacks on the health sector and innocent civilians since February 2021, by all possible means, and to stand with the suffering people of Myanmar.

Despite many difficulties and challenges, the Ministry of Health of the National Unity Government will put its ultimate efforts to continue providing health services together with our heroes healthcare professionals, ethnic organizations, local organizations, and the community. Until the military dictatorship is uprooted, we, together with the people of Myanmar, are committed to striving towards building a Federal Democratic Union.
